- Category II: The speech length should be of four minutes. A warning bell will be rung at the end of three minutes and thirty seconds informing the participants that they have only thirty seconds remaining to finish the speech.

Note: Speaking for more than four minutes and less than three minutes and thirty seconds will lead to disqualification.

- Reading from paper is not allowed.
- Decision of the judges will be final.

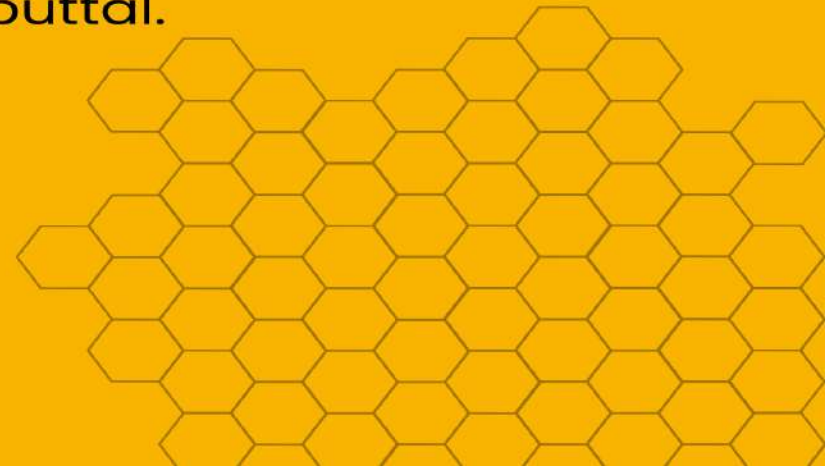
Rules



- Participants should avoid reading from a previously prepared script, any paper or aid. However, short notes are permitted.
- Each team can present only two participants - one to speak 'for the motion' and the other, 'against the motion'.
- The order of speech will be decided on the spot by draw of lots.
- For classes VIII to XI, each speaker will get three minutes to speak. At the end of two minutes and thirty seconds a warning bell will be rung. The final bell will be sounded at the end of the third minute.
- Timer will be set as soon as the participant starts speaking.



- The speakers will address the chair only. Un-parliamentary language, personal comments or observations on any religion, caste, community, political party or individuals are not allowed. The matter should be limited to the topic only. Such violations may lead to disqualification.
- Marks awarded by individual judges will be added up for each speaker; and then for each team.
- A lively rebuttal/refutation for approximately two minutes will follow each speech with interjections from the participants.
- Speakers will be adjudged on the basis of subject matter, diction, delivery, pronunciation, language, presentation and rebuttal.

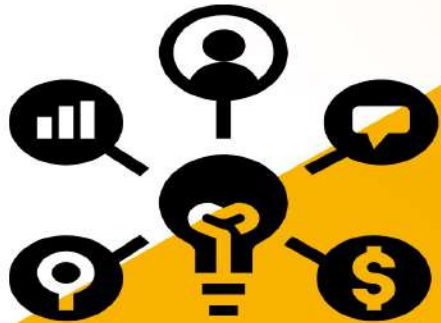




Event Details:
